## Judicial Entry

IN RE: LUCY MULLEN

CUSTODY 2151.23 ORC

Hearing held on the motion to stay part of the Court's order pending appeal.

The mother, Ms. Mullen, allowed a relationship to develop between the child and the petitioner, Ms. Hobbs, from her birth for approximately two years, until the relationship of the adults deteriorated and custody litigation was filed. The father was part of this encouragement too, although minor in nature.

The mother refused the child further contact with Ms. Hobbs.

A Magistrate of this Juvenile Court granted the child six consecutive hours of companionship/visitation with Ms. Hobbs, over a year ago while the litigation was in process. Another Judge of this Court affirmed and adopted that Magistrate's Decision. The companionship/visitation has been ongoing since that time.

This Court ruled on 4-13-2009 that Ms. Hobbs has no parental or other custodial rights with this child. The mother stopped the companionship/visitation in accordance with that Decision.


On 4-24-2009 Ms. Hobbs filed an Appeal of this Court's Decision and requested a stay regarding the termination of the earlier companionship/visitation order.

This Court hereby grants Ms. Hobbs' motion and that part of this Court's entry that terminates the interim companionship/visitation with the child.

Therefore Ms. Hobbs is to have six consecutive hours each week companionship/visitation with the child, Lucy Mullen, as before, until terminated or modified by the Appellate Court or until the Appellate Court otherwise rules on the Appeal of this matter.
